College Scholarship Application Requirements

- Completed Scholarship Application**
- Completed Statement of Financial Need (ASC Form)**
- A Personal Profile** telling your story, including:
 - **A Cover Letter** detailing your interest of study and commitment to a career in in any area of the grain industry or associated enterprise and detailing the value of such a career to the citizens of North America. **Must be in Word or PDF format.**
 - **Work and/or volunteer activities.** A list and description of your participation in the community and volunteer work, as well as work-related experiences during high school, college and/or current employment in ag-related business. Include work on a family farm, employer/supervisor contact information, dates of employment and the numbers of hours worked per week during the school year. **Must be in Word or PDF format.**
- Transcript** from your high school or current college or most recent evidence of achievement.
- Letter of recommendation** from an individual in the grain industry or associated enterprise or instructor as to the character and accomplishments of applicant. **NOTE: All Letters of Recommendation must be on letterhead and signed by the author OR sent directly to jan@ascapply.org from the author. All Letters should contain contact information to verify the letter.**

3. Receipt from a statement from the Bursar's or Financial Aid office showing the amount due for the semester.
