College Scholarship Application Requirements

- ☐ **Completed Scholarship Application**
- ☐ **Completed Statement of Financial Need (ASC Form)**
- ☐ **A Personal Profile** telling your story, including:
 - **A Cover Letter** detailing your interest of study and commitment to a career in any area of the grain industry or associated enterprise and detailing the value of such a career to the citizens of North America. **Must be in Word or PDF format—500-word minimum.**
 - **Work and/or volunteer activities.** A list and description of your participation in the community and volunteer work, as well as work-related experiences during high school, college, and/or current employment in ag-related business. Include work on a family farm, employer/supervisor contact information, dates of employment, and the number of hours worked per week during the school year. **Must be in Word or PDF format.**
- ☐ **Transcript** from your high school, current college, or most recent evidence of achievement.
- ☐ **Letter of recommendation** from an individual in the grain industry, an associated enterprise, or an instructor as to the character and accomplishments of the applicant. **NOTE: All Letters of Recommendation must be on letterhead and signed by the author OR sent directly to jan@ascapply.org from the author. All Letters should contain contact information to verify the letter.**

The Agriculture Scholarship Centre shall condition the award of the scholarship to a graduating high school senior, college student, full-time employee in a grain-related business, or other approved applicant upon:

1. The proposed recipient's admission to or continuing enrollment in a college/university or continuing education program.
2. Receiving an outline of the student's proposed course of study for the next semester at said college/university or continuing education program, reporting the enrolled agriculture course(s).
3. Receipt from a statement from the Bursar's or Financial Aid office showing the amount due for the semester.
