A Personal Profile telling your story, including:
 A Cover Letter detailing your interest of study and commitment to a career in any area of the grain industry or associated enterprise and detailing the value of such a career to the citizens of North America. Must be in Word or PDF format—500-word minimum.
Work and/or volunteer activities. A list and description of your participation in the community and volunteer work, as well as work-related experiences during high school, college, and/or current employment in ag-related business. Include work on a family farm, employer/supervisor contact information, dates of employment, and the number of hours worked per week during the school year. Must be in Word or PDF format.
Transcript from your high school, current college, or most recent evidence of achievement.
Letter of recommendation from an individual in the grain industry, an associated enterprise, or an instructor as to the character and accomplishments of the applicant. NOTE: All Letters of Recommendation must be on letterhead and signed by the author OR sent directly to jan@ascapply.org from the author. All Letters should contain contact information to verify the letter.
