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## College Scholarship Application Requirements

- ☐ **Completed Cover Letter (ASC Form)**
- ☐ **Completed Scholarship Application (ASC Form)**
- ☐ **Completed Statement of Financial Need (ASC Form)**
- ☐ **An Essay** (500-word minimum) on the value of a career in the grain industry in North America.
- ☐ **Resume with work and/or volunteer activities.** A list and description of your participation in the community and volunteer work, as well as work-related experiences during high school, college, and/or current employment in ag-related business. Include any involvement in 4-H, FFA, or AFA. Also include work on a family farm, employer/supervisor contact information, dates of employment, and the number of hours worked per week during the school year. Must be in Word or PDF format.
- ☐ **Transcript** from your high school or current college or most recent evidence of achievement.
- ☐ **Letter of recommendation** from an individual in the grain industry or associated enterprise or instructor as to the character and accomplishments of the applicant. NOTE: All Letters of Recommendation must be on letterhead and signed by the author OR sent directly to [jan@ascapply.org](mailto:jan@ascapply.org) from the author. All Letters should contain contact information to verify the letter.

***The Agriculture Scholarship Centre shall condition the award of the scholarship to a graduating high school senior, college student, full-time employee in a grain-related business, or other approved applicant upon:***

1. The proposed recipient's admission to or continuing enrollment in a college/university or continuing education program.
2. Receiving an outline of the student's proposed course of study for the next semester at said college/university or continuing education program reporting the enrolled agriculture course(s).
3. Receipt of a statement from the Bursar's or Financial Aid office showing the amount due for the semester.
