College Scholarship Application Requirements

- Completed Scholarship Application**

- A Personal Profile** telling your story, including:
 - **A Cover Letter** detailing your interest of study and commitment to a career in in any area of the grain industry or associated enterprise and detailing the value of such a career to the citizens of North America.
 - **A statement of your financial need.** Outline current year anticipated costs and sources of funds. Include detailed information about other scholarships, Pell Grants, student loans and personal or family contribution to your costs. Please include a statement with this information from your college, if available.
 - **Work and/or volunteer activities.** A list and description of your participation in the community and volunteer work, as well as work-related experiences during high school, college and/or current employment in ag-related business. Include work on a family farm, employer/supervisor contact information, dates of employment and the numbers of hours worked per week during the school year.

- Transcript** from your high school or current college or most recent evidence of achievement.

- Letter of recommendation** from an individual in the grain industry or associated enterprise or instructor as to the character and accomplishments of applicant.

The Agriculture Scholarship Centre shall condition the award of the scholarship to a graduating high school senior, college student, full time employee in a grain related business or other approved application upon:

1. The proposed recipient's admission to or continuing enrollment in a college/university or continuing education program.
2. Receiving an outline of the student's proposed course of study for the next semester at said college/university or continuing education program reporting the enrolled agricultures course(s).
3. Receipt from a statement from the Bursar's or Financial Aid office showing the amount due for the semester.
